> THE PHILIPPINES...

The Philippines is an island archipelago located in South East Asia, south of Taiwan and Hong Kong, and has one of the world's highest levels of endemism when it comes to birds. It is a popular birding destination and boasts an impressive 600 plus bird list with around 200 species of endemic birds. A wide variety of habitats supports the country's rich bird life: montane mossy and lowland tropical ort most of the endemics while freshwater marshes and coastal

forests support most of the endemics while freshwater marshes and coastal flats harbor migrants and resident waterbirds. Numerous uninhabitated islands provide food and shelter for pelagic birds while the urban greenery of major cities supports garden variety birds.

Some of the most sought-after birds in the Philippines include the majestic Great Philippine Eagle, the colorful Wattled Broadbill, the spectacular Steere's Pitta, Blue-capped and Spotted Wood Kingfishers, the endemic family of creepers - Rhabdornises and an assortment of fruit-doves, tailorbirds and shamas.

Birding in the Philippines involves visiting the three major bird areas hosting the majority of the endemics: the islands of Luzon, Mindanao and Palawan. Extension tours to the Visayan Islands in the central Philippines can increase the number of Philippine endemics to your lifelist. Being an island archipelago, the logistics are quite complex, but a good network of airports, seaports and roads connects all major birding destinations. English is widely spoken all throughout the country and we Filipinos are world-renowned for our hospitality, making us a prime destination for foreign birdwatchers.

The Philippines' Top Birding Destinations

> Luzon



Mt. Makiling Forest Reserve

This is an excellent site for introductory birding in the Philippines due to its close proximity to the capital city Manila. It features lowland endemics such as Spotted Wood Kingfisher, White-browed Shama, Grey-backed Tailorbird and many more.

Ideal time in the field: 2 days

Candaba Wetlands

One of largest freshwater marshes can be found in this excellent site an hour away from Manila. The marsh features migratory ducks and waterfowl and the endemic Philippine Duck.

Ideal time in the field: 1/2 day

Subic Bay Freeport Zone

This former American Naval base situated north-west of Manila has vast lowland forests featuring several kinds of woodpeckers, parrots and hornbills. Specialties here are Green Racquet-tail, Rufous Coucal, Philippine Tailorbird and Sooty Woodpecker.

Ideal time in the field: 2 days



Mt. Polis and Banaue


Mt. Polis is home to Luzon's montane forest and features high elevation birds such as Flame-breasted Fruit-dove, Whiskered Pitta, Flame-crowned Flowerpecker and Luzon Water-Redstart. It is also the site for the world-famous Banaue Rice Terraces.

Ideal time in the field: 2 days

> MINDANAO

Mt. Kitanglad Mountain Range

Mt. Kitanglad in Bukidnon features extensive montane forests and is the most reliable site for the Great Philippine Eagle. High elevation Mindanao birds are the specialty here such as the localized Red-eared Parrotfinch, Cinnamon Ibon, funky-looking Apo Myna, Black and Cinnamon Fantail and many more.









PICOP is a former logging concession in the eastern part of the island and is the best place to observe Mindanao lowland birds. Though much of the forest is fast disappearing, it still holds endemics such as the stunning Celestial and Short-crested Monarchs, Blue-capped and Rufous-lored Kingfishers, Steere's Pitta, several fruit-doves and imperial pigeons, Writhed, Tarictic and Rufous Hornbills.

Ideal time in the field: 4 days



Puerto Princesa Underground Park

The island of Palawan is probably the best site in the Philippines when it comes to accesibility and ease of birding. It features birdlife similar to mainland Asia but the island also hosts several endemics such as the Palawan Hornbill, Palawan Peacock Pheasant, Yellow-throated Leafbird, the skulking Falcated Ground Babbler and many more.

Ideal time in the field: 5-6 days
